Date of Council Meeting: Tuesday February 11 th , 2025		
Subject: Update Hours for Free Transit Service for Seniors		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff report that evaluates the financial and operational feasibility of expanding the hours for the free transit for seniors' program currently offered by Halifax Transit on Tuesdays to start earlier in the morning and end later in the day.		
Reason: The current free senior transit program operates from 10 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. every Tuesday. Seniors who use this free service on Tuesdays have appointments and errands outside of service times. This will make it more accessible for seniors to use this program and allow them to be able to get to their appointments and errands without having to worry about the time constraints of the current program.		
Outcome Sought: A staff report that evaluates the feasibility of expanding the free transit service for seniors that is currently offered by Halifax Transit.
