Subject: Options to Manage Congestion on Hammonds Plains Road and Lucasville Road		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff report on short and long-term options to manage traffic congestion on Hammonds Plains Road and Lucasville Road. Reason: Residents in these areas have expressed ongoing concerns regarding traffic congestion. I am seeking information on potential solutions to address this issue, including both short-term measures and long-term strategies. Outcome Sought: A staff report that provides short- and long-term options to manage congestion on Hammonds Plains Road and Lucasville Road. This would include consideration for construction mitigation options pertaining to road work, egress planning/community connectivity, transit options, and road network options. The report should consider the impacts of secondary planning in Sandy Lake, and the province's plans for a connection between Highway 101 and Hammonds Plains Road.
