This year's parades and remembrance of military personnel who served with valour and distinction and gave the ultimate sacrifice in the First World War, the Second World War, in the United Nations Peacekeeping missions and most recently in Afghanistan, will occur on Tuesday, 11 November 2025.

It is requested that the Halifax Regional Municipality grant permission for the Canadian Armed Forces to fly a Cyclone helicopter over the Grand Parade in Halifax at 1102 hours flying from North to South, Sullivan's Pond in Dartmouth at approximately 1108 hours flying North to South, over Cole Harbour Place at approximately 1109 hours flying East to West, and over the Caen Legion Branch #164 on Main Road in Eastern Passage at approximately 1110 hours flying North to South. Requesting fly pasts be authorized to fly at a height of 500 feet above the highest obstacle in each location.
