<b>Subject: Movement of the HRP Integrated Emergency Response Communicators</b>		
<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b>  That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer to prepare a staff report that identifies the financial and logistical implications of moving the HRP Integrated Emergency Response Communicators from the HRP Business Unit to a HRM Business Unit.  <b>Reason:</b> Emergency Response Communicators are highly trained civilian employee for the HRP; while, they serve an important role in Police operations. In addition to supporting Police, these positions provide support to HRFE and non-emergency calls. These positions should be considered to be part of a different business instead of the HRP business unit as they provide support to multiple business units.  <b>Outcome Sought:</b> Staff report outlining the financial and logistical implications of moving the HRP Integrated Emergency Response Communicators from the HRP Business Unit to a HRM Business Unit.
