Subject : Halifax Transit to consider a connector bus from Lucasville Road to Timber Trails to the Sackville Terminal		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer to prepare a staff report and presentation to Halifax Transit to consider a connector bus from Lucasville Road to Timber Trails Trailer Park to the Sackville Terminal. The report should include data on the vehicle daily traffic numbers- with peak period during the day-Monday to Friday and Saturday to Sunday on the Lucasville Road, potential transit stops, potential cross walk locations, potential size of the community transit terminal at the Timber Trails Trailer Park, potential size of the community transit terminal (park and ride) at the Timber Trails Trailer Park, potential hourly schedule times for the connector bus on this proposed transit route, a future community engagement for this potential connector bus route, any potential land acquisition, any potential infrastructure planning prior to project implementation which would include the residents of Lucasville.		
Reason: Halifax Transit does not provide a service for the Lucasville Road or the Lucasville Community but does have a transit route that drives across Lucasville Road to service communities in Middle Sackville and along the Old Sackville Road.		
Outcome Sought: A staff report with baseline data and initiatives that would include this transit service for residents of Lucasville, which would the residents on Lucasville Road, Bryanston, Waterstone, Viscount Run, Kingswood Drive, Timber Trails Trailer Park and adjacent streets of Lucasville.
